Homeless Veterans stats to May 31, 2019

The Ontario Homeless Veterans program has provided assistance to 752 clients in 149 towns, of these 752 clients 75 are female, 5 veterans from Quebec have been helped, 3 Indigenous veterans from Mohawk Territory and one US Veteran.

The following is a breakdown, by Zone, of assistance that has been provided to homeless or near homeless veterans within District 'G'. A breakdown is also provided for the assistance provided to veterans outside of District 'G' by the Provincial Command.
